final certification costs for a deserving industry professional, student or volunteer to attain IFEA's Certified Festival & Event Executive (CFEE) designation through the CFEE FastTrack program. The CFEE FastTrack program will be offered online in the spring and fall, as well as in person at the IFEA Convention & Expo, and rotates through all six (6) required core curriculum courses.

Each scholarship is designed to support and encourage selected and target-

ed individuals. Applicants must meet the criteria outlined for the specific scholarship (see above) that they are applying for and cannot be in a financial position to attend without scholarship assistance. Once these requirements are met, applicants are considered on their cultural diversity, professional aspirations, course of study (if a student), and statement of benefit to themselves and/or their organizations and communities as the result of attaining a CFEE education.

Conditions for Application:

To apply and be eligible to receive the *Daniel A. Mangeot Memorial Scholarship* for the IFEA's Certified Festival & Event Executive (CFEE) program, recipients must demonstrate and document the following:

- That they meet the targeted criteria as a deserving professional seeking advanced education and professional certification through the attainment of the IFEA's Certified Festival & Event Executive (CFEE) designation.
- 2. That they have not already begun the CFEE program.
- That they could not otherwise, through any other means, afford to pay the complete CFEE registration fees.

4. That they and/or their organization are a current member, in good standing, of the IFEA.

Applicants (professionals and students) should answer all applicable questions on the application (write N/A where something is non-applicable) and include direct contact information as requested. An incomplete application will not be considered.

Scholarship recipients will be determined and notified by Monday, June 10, 2024.

Due to the limited number of scholarships available, any applicant and/ or organization receiving scholarship assistance using falsified information, or failing to use an awarded scholarship (aside from consideration of acceptable and unforeseen circumstances, as defined and approved by the IFEA Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee) will be prohibited from applying for future scholarship assistance.
