- > Festival Hours:
Thursday June 24th - Sunday June 27th, noon-11 pm
- > Location:
Library Square, 200 East at 400 South, Salt Lake City
- > Admission:
Adults \$7; Seniors (60+) \$3.50; Kids (12 & under) FREE
- > Discounts:
Lunchtime Special (Thurs/ Fri, noon-3 pm), \$3.50

ROAD CLOSURE

- > 200 East will be closed between 400 and 500 South from Tues June 22 at 6 pm until Tues June 28.

PUBLIC ACCESS

- > Access the City Library through the main entrances
- > Enter the City County building from State Street.
- > City and County building employees will have free access of the festival grounds on Thurs and Fri during working hours 12-5 p.m. with employee ID.

PARKING

- > Parking near the site will fill quickly during peak times.
- > 1200 pay parking slots lie directly below the Library. The cost is 75¢ per hour up to \$12.00.
- > Park for free at the Board of Education Building on 500 S 250 E after business hours (limited space).
- > Ride a bike and check it for free at the valet bike lot near the 400 South Arts Fest entrance.
- > Avoid the hassle: Ride TRAX; there is a stop right across the street from Library Square.
- > Free parking at all UTA park and ride lots, and at Rice-Eccles Stadium (except Thurs/Fri 11 am-4pm).
